

# Coronavirus Crisis Response



Ceres Community Project is part of Marin and Sonoma County's emergency food response during COVID-19. At this time, we are prioritizing our services for the following populations:

- People with acute health challenges, who do not have the financial resources to access for-profit meal delivery services such as Hello Fresh, Blue Apron, etc. and who are not able to prepare meals and do not have a family member or caregiver who can prepare meals
- People who have been diagnosed with COVID-19, are medically fragile, and lack financial and family support to prepare meals
- Medically fragile people who are required to shelter in place and who are living at or below 200% of the federal poverty level and lack family support to prepare meals

If you meet our criteria, call our Client Intake Line and someone will get back to you in the next 48 business hours to verify your eligibility and complete an intake. Please keep in mind that it will take up to three weeks to receive your first delivery of 7 prepared meals per week.

We are currently working to expand our service capacity to meet growing demand. If you complete an intake with our Client Care Team, we will move you into service as quickly as we are able.
